19. ZDRAVOTNICKÝ PERSONÁL

There are many people who contribute to your care while you are in hospital. Numerous people and services work together to provide you with successful treatment in a hospital.

The roles of staff in a hospital can be divided into four areas:

- doctors
- nurses
- allied health professionals
- support staff.

Doctors:

They together assess and manage your medical care.

Depending on which hospital you are in, you may also be treated by interns and student doctors who work under the supervision of the senior doctors. Doctors must have a six-year degree in general medicine and a few years of specialization.

Nurses:

Nurses manage most of your ongoing care and treatment in hospital.

They assess, plan, and administer your daily treatment and manage your general health. They can also direct you to the right people to speak to about specific medical issues.

Support staff:

Hospital support staff you may meet during your stay include auxiliary nurse (she needs secondary school of nurse), porters, cleaner.

Part of a hospital staff is also.

nursing officer (university)

midwife (high school and a bachelor's degree)

anesthetic (he needs faculty of medicine)

scrub nurse (extension or university)

surgeon (he needs education as a doctor)

paramedic (high school and a bachelor's degree)

triage nurse.
